- The second and final day of pool play. Following the completion of pool play, a representative must sign off on and receive his bracket schedule resulting from pool play. Your placement in the brackets will depend on your finish in pool play. The top 2 teams will advance to the double-elimination Championship Bracket.

Tuesday, July 3, 2007

- The first day of the Championship Bracket and modified Double Elimination Bracket.

Note:

- The home team (white jersey) is listed first in pool play.
- The home team (white jersey) is listed on top in bracket play.
- All bench personnel, both male and female, must adhere to the Coaches Dress Code by wearing a shirt with a collar, long pants or dress shorts/skirts, closed toe shoes, plus no hats may be worn while on the bench or during Opening Ceremonies. Each violation to the bench rule will result in a technical foul (administrative, not charged to the coach). Example: If a person is charged with the technical foul then he/she must leave the bench area until his/her attire meets the code.

Day 1	Team Registration, Coaches' Meeting, Opening Ceremony - and Officials' Meeting.
Day 2	Competition begins with pool play.
Day 3	Pool play competition concludes.
Day 4	Championship bracket play begins (Double Elimination). If more than 32 teams - Classic Tournament begins.
Day 5	Bracket play continues for National Championship/Classic Tournaments.
Day 6	Bracket play continues for National Championship/Classic Tournaments.
Day 7/8	Championship play concludes Award Ceremony
