Note:

- The home team (white jersey) is listed first in pool play.
- The home team (white jersey) is listed on top in bracket play.
- All bench personnel, both male and female, must adhere to the Coaches Dress Code by wearing a shirt with a collar, long pants or dress shorts/skirts, closed toe shoes, plus no hats may be worn while on the bench or during Opening Ceremonies. Each violation to the bench rule will result in a technical foul (administrative, not charged to the coach).
