Tournament Rules



HOME TEAM

Listed first in pool play and listed on top in bracket play and sits to the left of the score table. Wears white/light colored uniform.

GAME TIME

- ➤ Warm-Up 5 minutes
- Two 16-minute halves for ages 14u, 15u, 16u and 19u
- Four 7-minute quarters for ages 10u, 11u, 12u and 13u
- Half Time 4 minutes
- > Overtime: 4 minutes, 3 minutes for 10u

GAME RULES - NCAA Women's Rules

- > 30 second shot clock
- No 10 second back court
- > TIMEOUTS: 3 full time outs and two 30-second time outs for 10u, 11u, 12u and 13u
- TIMEOUTS: 4 full time outs and two 30-second time outs for 14u, 15u, and 16u
- MERCY RULE: In the 8u, 9u, 10u, 11u, 12u, 13u divisions a running clock will be used in the second half when a team is behind by 30 or more points. Regular rules will return if at any time the spread falls below 30 points. The losing coach may opt to ignore this rule at any time.

PLAYERS' JERSEYS - must have numbers on both the front and back. Numbers can be 00-99. Minimum size of numbers shall be 2" on the front and 4" on the back.

PLAYER FOUL RULE - for District Qualifying Tournaments, Super Regional Tournaments and National Championships.

- A player will be disqualified on her 5th personal foul in the 8u, 9u, 10u, 11u, 12u and 13u.
- A player will be disqualified on her 6th personal foul in the 14u, 15u, 16u and 19u.

NO ONE FROM EITHER TEAM IS ALLOWED TO SIT AT THE SCORER'S TABLE. We provide an official scorer, a clock keeper and a shot clock keeper.

BE COURTEOUS to the next team and pick up around your bench after the game.

Game Time is forfeit time. Please arrive early to all games.

QUALIFYING FOR AAU NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

NUMBER OF TEAMS PER AGE DIVISION IN SUPER REGIONAL

0 - 3 Teams —1 DI bid, 1 DII bid, and 1 DIII bid

4 - 6 Teams — 2 DI bids, 2 DII bids, and 2 DIII bids

7 - 9 Teams — 3 DI bids, 3 DII bids, and 3 DIII bids

10 or more Teams — 4 DI bids, 4 DII bids, and 4 DIII bids

Teams that receive an invitation (Bid), from the Super Regional Championship to the National Championship shall play in their District Championship to validate their bid. If a team receives an invitation (Bid), but is unable to play in their District Championship, they must submit a written request stating the reason(s) they were unable to participate. The AAU Girls Basketball Committee will determine if the team is eligible to use their bid.
