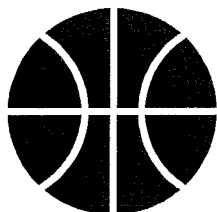

Louisiana Kings crowned AAU National Champions

FORT MILL, S.C. - Tournament MVP Gerrod Henderson scored 15 points and added nine rebounds and Chemelle Cauther added 15 points in leading the Louisiana Kings to the Senior Boys AAU Basketball Championship for the second straight year with a 79-63 win over YOMCA from Memphis, Tenn.

"It feels good to win again. This is a great win for the basketball fans of the state of Louisiana," said Kings head coach David Francis.
